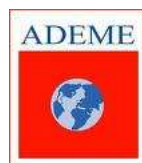

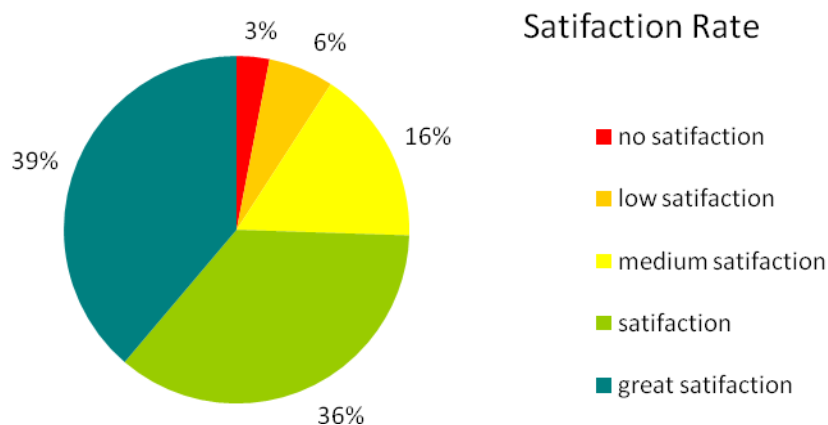
In line with the Concerto-Renaissance program initiated and supported by the EU, Local Energy Agency of Greater Lyon and AREF Rhône-Alpes designed and presented a training on « Airtightness of buildings» meant for trainers from building trade schools or training facilities from 16th to 18th June 2010.

This action occurred in partnership with IFBTP Rhône-Alpes, with the collaboration of AFPA Lyon-Sud and the kind participation of Bouwfonds-Marignan, one of the building-owners of the Concerto area.

This 20-hour-long training was aimed to help the trainees to integrate the airtightness issues as soon as possible into their current training courses, in order to fit to the soon-coming energy efficiency regulation.

The 17 trainees were teachers from the following training centers Fédération Compagnonnique des Métiers du Bâtiment (Villeurbanne, Echirolles), AFPA Lyon Sud, CFABTP Nord Isère, GRETA (Lyon, Roanne, Valence), NEOPOLIS (CCI 26), Lycée Professionnel Lamarque (Rillieux), Ecole BOISARD (Vaulx-en-Velin).

This action is a first-of-its-kind in the Rhône-Alpes region. With a 75% satisfaction rate, this experiment can be considered as a positive one.



We identified the potential improvements below :

- *Specific support handbook (useful during and after the session)*
- *Visual media resources (re-usable by the trainees into their own courses)*
- *A refocused hands-on sequence*
- *Better management of heterogenous group (by a finer pedagogical differentiation or by splitting in two distinct sessions).*
